

## Peter William McBride (1827-1874) of Bladen County, NC Discharge Documents










P W McBride, Sir you are hereby ordered to report at Capt Kelly's residence on Wednesday the 14 \_\_\_\_ at 4 oclock PM with four days rations gun ammunition by order of Major Monroe by Capt Kelly. J C Melvin Lt. **Note:** Back of note has typed date of 1862, which may or may not indicate the year this was ordered.






Elizabethtown, NC, Sept 16<sup>th</sup>, 1863. I certify, upon honor, that I have carefully examined Peter W. McBryde a private of Col Lucas **55<sup>th</sup> Reg NCM**, and find him incompetent to perform military duty, because of curvature of spine which I consider permanent. The said Peter McBryde is hereby exempt from service in the Army of the Confederate States, subject to re-examination and enrollment when ordered by the board. J.T. Cypress Creek, Sept the  $20^{th}$ , 1864, Mr. W McBride you are hereby ordered to report at the Brown Marsh Depot on Thursday  $22^{nd}$  August with three days ration a blanket and a gun in order to remain out for sixty days.
